The position is based in Meissen, Germany. Alternative locations such as Madrid, Spain may also be considered for the right candidate.

- Primary focus on legal, commercial and technical project Due Diligence to ensure the highest quality of UKA's project developments
- Identify legal, commercial and technical risks and how to reduce these risks
